## Cadet<sup>®</sup> herbicide: THE Flexible Postemergence Soybean & Corn Herbicide

### Corn and Soybean Use Rates:

- ☐ 0.4-0.6 oz./A – Tank mix with labeled rates of glyphosate herbicide on Roundup Ready<sup>®</sup> soybeans or Liberty<sup>®</sup> on LibertyLink<sup>®</sup> soybeans
- ☐ 0.5-0.9 oz./A – Control of labeled weeds alone or tank mixed with other postemergence herbicides

### Application Timing:

- ☐ Soybean – Apply from Pre-Plant to Full Flowering
- ☐ Corn – Apply from Pre-Plant to 48 inches but before tassel

### Adjuvants:

Apply with NIS at 1qt/100 gal or Crop Oil Concentrate at 1-2 pt./A. UAN at 1-2 qt./A or AMS at 8-17 lb/100 gallon may be added. If applying with glyphosate herbicide that contains an adjuvant or with Liberty herbicide no additional NIS is required with Cadet herbicide.

### Application Volume:

Apply minimum 15 gallons water by ground; 5 gallons by air

Crop rotation becomes more important in a compressed season due to delayed or later postemergence applications. Later applications of some postemergence herbicides will narrow the planting window of the following crop. Cadet herbicide has no plant back restrictions and allows greater flexibility in crop rotation.

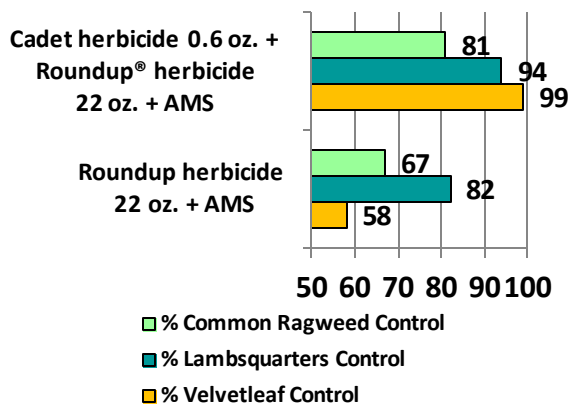

## 2013 Selected Treatments Postemergence Soybean Herbicide Trial

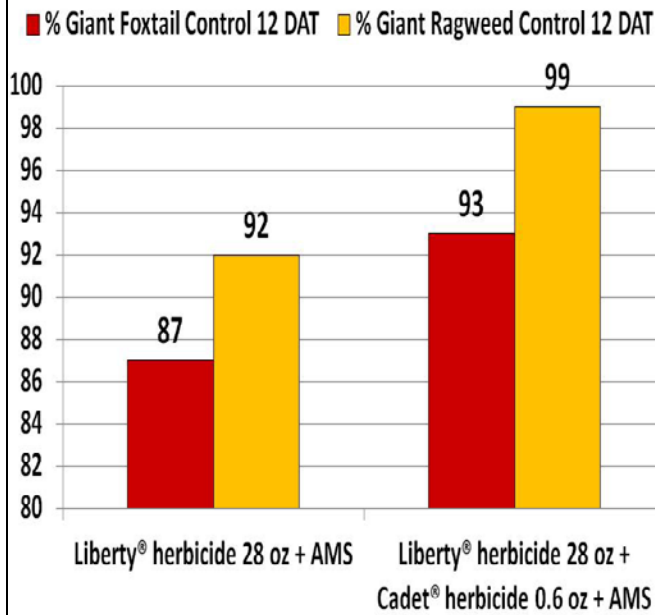
