CORN PRODUCERS: Clean-Up your Corn With Cadet[®] Herbicide or Aim[®] EC Herbicide Alone or Tankmixed, Applied by Drop Nozzles



Postemergence Applications: Use Cadet herbicide 0.6-0.9 oz./A, or Aim EC herbicide 1-2 oz./A with drop nozzle equipped sprayer ground application equipment using a minimum finished spray volume of 15 gallons of finished spray per acre by ground. May make drop nozzle or shielded sprayer applications to corn up to 48 inches tall. Increase spray volume above 15 gallons of finished spray per acre where dense weed canopies exist.

Weeds controlled up to 4-6 inches tall include: burcucumber, jimsonweed, lambsquarters, morningglories, nighshade, pigweed, - redroot, smooth; Pa. smartweed, velvetleaf, waterhemp - tall. Tank-mixing is advised to broaden weed spectrum and for herbicide resistance management. Aim EC herbicide and Cadet herbicide tank mix easily with Roundup in Roundup Ready[®] Corn and with Liberty in LibertyLink[®] Corn for better weed control and providing excellent crop rotation flexibility.

Cadet herbicide, Aim EC herbicide, Aim EC herbicide tankmixes and Cadet herbicide tankmixes may be applied with drop nozzles. Drop nozzles allow optimum placement of herbicides resulting in better spray coverage. Excellent weed control in corn is attained that would otherwise become weedy later in the season. Read and follow all label directions.

Cadet herbicide 0.6 oz. + glyphosate 24 oz. 10 DAT – 2007 Note excellent broadleaf weed control and soybean tolerance.



Cadet herbicide 0.6 oz. + Stanza® herbicide 4 oz. 43 DAT – 2015 Applied with drop nozzles controlling Giant Ragweed 1" tall versus untreated check in upper right hand corner.

Consider Cadet® herbicide for a delayed PRE or Early POST, into POST applications for corn and soybean weed control. Cadet herbicide may be tankmixed with various POST herbicides labeled for corn or soybeans.

Cadet Herbicide Use Recommendations for Corn (Field, Pop) and Soybeans

0.4-0.6 oz./A - Tank-mixed with glyphosate herbicides, such as Roundup, in (glyphosate resistant) Roundup Ready® Corn or Soybeans. May be tankmixed with Liberty in (glufosinate resistant) LibertyLink® Corn or Soybeans.

0.7-0.9 oz./A – Control of labeled weeds alone or with post grass herbicide.

Corn- Pre-Plant Burndown, Delayed Pre-Emergence, Postemergence through postemergence corn stages to 48 inches tall (VE to 48 inches).

Soybeans - Pre-Plant Burndown, Delayed Pre-Emergence, Postemergence through full flowering (VE to R1).

Adjuvants - Apply with NIS at 1qt./100 gal or Crop Oil Concentrate at 1-2 pt./A. UAN at 1-2 qts./A or AMS at 8-17 lb/100 gallon may be added. If applying with glyphosate herbicide that contains an adjuvant, no additional NIS is required with Cadet herbicide.

Restrictions: Do not apply within 60 days of soybean harvest or 70 days of corn harvest.
